Rebate Application – Lawn/High-Volume Irrigation Replacement: Rules & Requirements

1. These rebates require a pre-inspection by District staff. **Do not start work until after the pre-inspection.** A representative of the District must be permitted to inspect the property to verify installation and presence of relevant fixtures/features. To schedule an inspection, submit a signed copy of this form and call (831) 438-2363 or email conservation@svwd.org. The account holder or authorized representative must be present during all inspections. **Failure to schedule a pre-inspection will result in the application being denied as incomplete.**
2. A post-inspection verifying replacement of relevant fixture/features **must be completed within 180 days of pre-inspection for approval.** A representative of the District must be permitted to inspect the property to verify completion of work. To schedule an inspection, please call (831) 438-2363 or email conservation@svwd.org. The account holder or authorized representative must be present during all inspections.
3. For lawn replacement rebates, applicant must convert lawn or turf to low water use plants and/or permeable landscape such as mulch, decomposed granite, permeable pavers, and/or artificial turf. Existing sprinkler heads must be either converted to drip or other low-volume emitters or removed and capped. High and low-volume emitters must not exist on the same valve.
4. For low-volume irrigation rebates, applicant must replace high-volume pop-up riser sprayers with low-volume emitters such as drip, inline, or micro sprayers. Existing sprinkler heads must be either converted to drip or other low-volume emitters or removed and glue capped. High and low-volume emitters must not exist on the same valve.
5. If approved, applicant agrees that all fixtures/features will remain in place for five (5) years.
6. The credited equipment/features must be installed in an existing SVWD service address. New development is not eligible for rebates.
7. Rebates will be issued in the form of a mailed check unless a request is made for account credit. Please allow four (4) weeks from the date of approval for processing.
8. The account must be in good financial standing to receive a rebate check. If the account is not in good standing, then a credit would be applied to the applicant's District account.
9. Installation of any device, appliance or fixture is the sole responsibility of the applicant, as is determination of the adequacy and compatibility of the existing plumbing system.
10. The District does not endorse specific brands, products or dealers; nor does it guarantee materials or workmanship; acceptance of such is customer's responsibility.
11. The District assumes no responsibility or liability for any damage that may occur to an applicant's property as a result of participation in the program. Due to circumstances beyond its control, the District cannot guarantee that installation of rebated fixtures or measures will result in lower utility costs.
12. All installations must follow the California Universal Plumbing Code. For information on California building codes please visit <https://www.library.ca.gov/law/building-standards/>.
13. The applicant is solely responsible for the proper disposal of all materials associated with the installation of credited fixtures and equipment and SVWD assumes no responsibility or liability. Please recycle materials.
14. All communications regarding the rebate process will occur via email.
15. SVWD may at any time modify this program without prior written notice. Prior versions of this form are obsolete.
16. Incomplete or illegible applications will be denied.
