Rebate Application – Smart Irrigation Controller Rules & Requirements

1. This rebate requires a dated sales receipt showing itemized cost, make and model of the rebated item(s). For online purchases, a copy of the final invoice or a packing or delivery slip with the same information is required. **Purchases made more than 90 days prior to application will not be processed.**
2. To qualify for a weather-based irrigation controller rebate, the controller must be EPA WaterSense Certified **AND** either: a **sensor-based controller that uses on-site weather or solar sensors to create irrigation schedules; OR:** a signal-based controller that **relies on daily weather updates received via satellite or internet.**
3. Irrigation controllers with rain sensors alone are not eligible for this rebate.
4. Rebate eligible parts include the control-head assembly only. Additional components of a greater system are not eligible.
5. The rebate is not to exceed the purchase price of the eligible parts. Sales tax, shipping and labor are not included.
6. If approved, applicant agrees that all fixtures/features will remain in place for five (5) years.
7. All equipment must be installed in an existing SVWD service address. New development is not eligible for rebates.
8. Rebates will be issued in the form of a mailed check unless a request is made for account credit. Please allow four (4) weeks from the date of approval for processing.
9. The account must be in good standing to receive a rebate.
10. Installation of any device, appliance or fixture is the sole responsibility of the applicant, as is determination of the adequacy and compatibility of the existing plumbing system.
11. The District does not endorse specific brands, products or dealers; nor does it guarantee materials or workmanship; acceptance of such is customer's responsibility.
12. The District assumes no responsibility or liability for any damage that may occur to an applicant's property as a result of participation in this program. Due to circumstances beyond its control, the District cannot guarantee that installation of rebated fixtures or measures will result in lower utility costs.
13. All installations must follow the California Universal Plumbing Code. For information on California building codes please visit <https://www.library.ca.gov/law/building-standards/>.
14. The applicant is solely responsible for the proper disposal of all materials associated with the installation of credited fixtures and equipment. The District assumes no responsibility or liability for waste disposal. Please recycle materials.
15. All communications regarding the rebate process will occur via email. If you do not receive a confirmation of receipt via email within 7 business days of submission, please contact the District Conservation Department at (831) 438-2363.
16. The District may at any time modify this program without prior written notice. Prior versions of this form are obsolete and will not be accepted.
17. Incomplete or illegible applications will be denied.
